

Flubaroo with Google Forms/Sheets

What Does Flubaroo Do?

Flubaroo is an add-on module within Google Sheets. The add-on allows users to automate the “grading” by allowing teachers to upload an answer key and then have questions scored and reported automatically (once students have submitted their responses through Google Forms).

Before You Start

You should be comfortable with Google Forms. As a self-check, make sure you can perform the following tasks before attempting to complete this Professional Development. You should be able to

- access Google Drive through a web browser;
- creating Google Sheets within Google Drive using a web browser;
- create a Google Form that students can complete and submit;
- create Google Sheets that display students’ responses from a linked Google Form.

What You Will Learn

By the end of Professional Development Cycle, you will understand how to install, enable, and utilize Flubaroo to automate grading. Specific skills you will master throughout this development cycle include

- associating Flubaroo with your Google Account;
- creating answer keys for Flubaroo grading;
- activating the Flubaroo add-on for a specific sheet;
- assigning which questions Flubaroo should grade, ignore, and/or allow for “hand grading”;
- creating self-grading Google Forms with automated feedback emails.

You will also understand where to find additional help on the Flubaroo website.

Flubaroo is updated semi-regularly. When it is updated, there is an automatic message displayed when you log into any Google Sheet which has Flubaroo enabled.
